










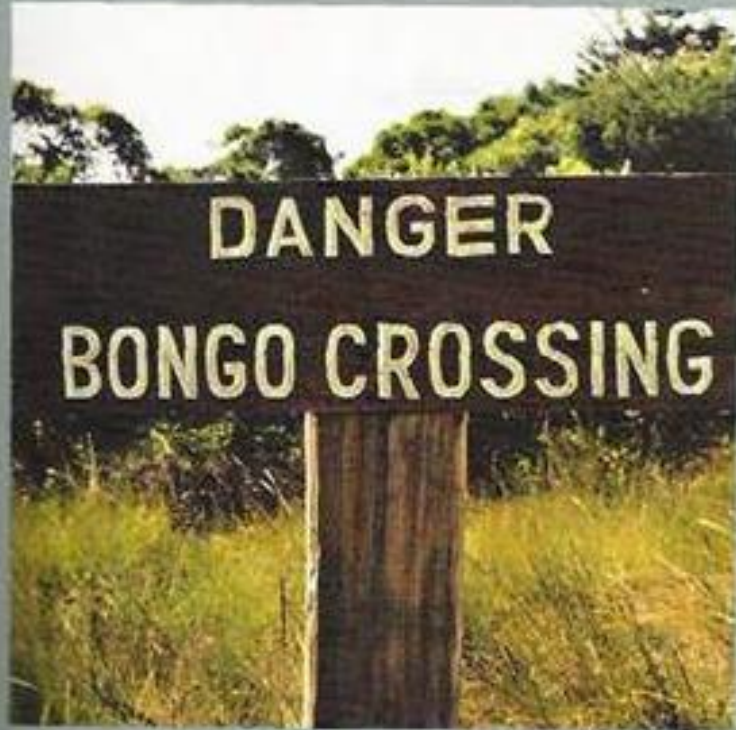

Gould took the cover photo in Kenya. A bongo is a chestnut-coated, spiral-horned antelope.
